Venue Access



- The gates at Spa Park open at 7am and close at 8pm.
- Outside of these hours the course is still accessible but make sure to park outside the gate to avoid getting locked in.

- Event HQ is next to the lower carpark (centrally located within the course).
- The main toilet block is at Event HQ. There is a second toilet block at the river/hot springs area and also portaloo's around the course.
- A water fountain can be found at the far end of the lower carpark. Additional water stations will be setup around the park and at Event HQ.
- Food vendors will be available at Event HQ each day and there are multiple food options nearby in town.





- Spa Park is a stunning shared use park on the northern edge of New Zealand's most beautiful small town, Taupō.
- With the park being open to the public at all times, please have safety front of mind before throwing. It is commonly used by walkers and cyclists.
- Please treat the park with respect and use rubbish bins for all litter.
- See the event caddy book or tee signs for a detailed desriptions of each hole and its design.





NEW ZEALAND



- Spa Park is a shared public space. We have booked the park for the event, however other park users will continue to be around.
- We have a team of volunteers marshaling to assist with safety, flow and spotting.
 They will be wearing yellow hi-vis vests; please follow their directions.
- If there are no marshals available at a hole use a player from your group to ensure it's played safely.



- Group 1 (MPO, MP40, MP50 and MA1) all play the Gold layout. (68 players).
- Group 2 (FPO, FA1, MA40, FA40, MA50 and MA2) all play the shorter Blue layout. (66 players).
- Both groups always play to the same basket. The layouts differences are achieved by tee position and par leniency.
- Please check the Caddy Book for detailed hole info, available at taupodiscgolf.com and within the official event app.



- The official and authorative scoring system for this event is PDGA Digital Scorecard.
- The event scoring code will be given out before your round begins.
- Every player must keep score for all members of the card.
- Please ensure your phones have the PDGA app installed and are charged. Paper scorecards are available on request.
- Fully submit all scorecards immediately after finishing your round.





- Alcohol or drug use is forbidden during play at all PDGA sanctioned events and will result in disqualification.
- This is a smoke free event. No smoking or vaping during your rounds, spectating play or at Event HQ.
- Please also ensure you dress smartly and meet PDGA dress code policy for A-Tier events.
 Collared shirts are encouraged.





- The course becomes closed for practise 2 minutes before the first tee time of the day (8am), until after the final card has finished hole 18.
- There are 2 practise areas (for long and short games) which will remain open during rounds for you to warm up. See the event map for locations.
- You must check-in with the official starter at the 1st tee at least five minutes before your scheduled start time.
- The optional 2m rule is not in play for this event.





(5) Speed of Play



- Please be aware of your groups pace. If other cards are starting to back up behind you, please try and speed up.
- Throw a provisional if your disc may be lost and you are not sure if it has gone out of bounds.
- Search as a group for up to 3 minutes (no longer) when trying to locate lost discs.
- Groups are not allowed to 'play through' during tournament play.



Out of Bounds

- All OB is marked by string or white painted lines and has white stakes for visual assistance.
- Normal OB rules apply for all holes except for Hole 2 (optional dropzone) and Holes 7 and 11 (if OB play from the dropzone).

Play-Offs

- Any tied divisions after 54 holes of regular play will be decided by sudden-death playoff.
- Play-offs will only be played to determine the division winner (ie not for other placings).
- The play-off holes are numbers 1, 2, and 3 (repeating as required).
- Any required play-offs will begin shortly after the completion of that division. This may impact start times for later cards.
